The National 4-H Conference Center Renovation Project involved programming, space planning, architectural design, and construction contract administration for the complete renovation of two (2) existing buildings (a total of 15,000 square feet). The completed work also included interior design, as well as, facilities management.

This new 7,500 square foot conference suite originally consisted of office spaces and was transformed into a suite of six (6) conference rooms that contained folding partitions, motorized pull-down screens, data/com connections, and facilities for tele-conferencing.
