The Howard University Law School Renovation Project (West Campus) involved programming, design, and construction contract administration for the complete renovation of three (3) existing buildings (a total of 300,000 square feet), and the addition of a 15,000 square foot classroom building and atrium. The completed work also included interior design, landscape restoration, and various site improvements.

This project also consisted of developing a revised campus plan for the District of Columbia, Office of Zoning's review and record for campus expansion. Expansion opportunities included the classroom building addition and an eventual new law school library building.
