The Hearst Park Landscape Design Improvements is in response to the request from the Community to provide a new playground for toddlers (2-5 years) and school-age children (6-12 years), a basketball court, a community gathering and sitting area, and a soccer field. Tasks included the design and selection of state-of-the-art playground equipment, improving general accessibility of the site with regard to pedestrian circulation and handicap access, hosting community workshops for playground designs, providing a series of functional spaces complementing the playground, incorporating native plant material and rain-gardens, and improving the overall usability of the site by the local community.
